




BOND DECLARES WINNERS for its 1ST DIGITAL CONTESTS


The winning entries had finally been identified which best depicted the theme for the respective contests.








TRISIANNI KING (1st PRIZE winner of BCWD 1st Digital Essay Writing Contest)

BCWD CELEBRATES ITS 47^H ANNVERSARY in th





The said Local contests were open to all concessionaires of BCWD ages 18 years old and above but with limited slot offered.


A Memorandum of Agreement signing for one hectare Adopt-a-Forest Project also took place as part of the said celebration.

NEDIA PRACTITIONERS OF BUTUAN CITY VISIT BEND BULK WATER SUPPLIER SITE and TAGUIDO WATERSHED

A group of media practitioners of Butuan City visited some facilities of the Butuan City Water District (BCWD) on March 6, 2021.







As part of the program of the BCWD **Community Relations and External** Affairs Division, fostering linkages other partner agencies, with media and organizations is also considered important for BCWD as they in turn will also support BCWD in its programs and activities. As such, BCWD always welcomes requests for site visit as it serves as an opportunity to better understand the project and/or activities of BCWD.

It can be recalled that the Taguibo Water Supply Development and Water Treatment Facility Service Project is now complete with the official start of its commercial operation last April 30, 2018. The Taguibo Aquatech Solutions Corporation (TASC) has already been operating the treatment facility for several years now at Sitio Iyao, Brgy. Anticala. the facility since its commercial operations. Thus, the mediamen were given the opportunity to visit the area and had been apprised of the current operations of BCWD and how it works with its bulk water supplier.

During the briefing and site visit, topics discussed include: the current water supply system of BCWD; Pressure Management; High Consumption Complaints; Water Meter Maintenance Fee; the construction of Water Supply System for Butuan City Rural Barangays Project; and Future Plans of BCWD.

Around eight (8) media personalities visited the facilities of BCWD's bulk water supplier – TASC. The visit made the media practitioners understand better the operations of water supply in Butuan City.
