

Donor Update

We have a total of five (5) new donors for our Adopt-a-Forest Program for the 2nd semester of 2022. The late **Dr. Juanito A. Lao**, represented by his wife, Ms. Helen C. Lao, and **Atty. Roldan Torralba**, represented by his wife, Ms. Marlita T. Torralba signed a Memorandum of Agreement (*MOA*) with BCWD on November 29, 2022, for one (1) hectare reforestation project. **One Meralco Foundation, Inc.** also signed a MOA with BCWD in September 29, 2022, for an equivalent of eighty (80) hectares reforestation project. **Agusan del Norte Electric Cooperative, Inc.** (*ANECO Inc.*), a non-stock, non-profit electric cooperative also signed MOA with BCWD in August 2022, for one (1) hectare reforestation project. **Architect Horacio T. Santos** also signed a MOA with BCWD in June 2, 2022, for one (1) hectare reforestation project.

For the 2nd semester of 2022, a total of 69 hectares Adopt-A-Forest Program were maintained in the Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve, the main source of BCWD's main water supply.

BCWD submitted its project proposal to OMF entitled Adopt-a-Forest Program: the One for Trees Project in the Taguibo Watershed last May 06, 2022. The project is in collaboration between Adopt-a-Forest and OMF's One for Trees project.

The proposed project aims to reforest eighty (80) hectares in the Taguibo Watershed and within the Certificate of Ancestral Domain of CADT-135 or to plant approximately 48,000 seedlings. It has a total budget of ₱5,051,000.00. The OMF will shoulder ₱ 4,000,000.00 while BCWD will provide a counterpart in the amount of ₱1,051,000.00. Said project proposal has a period of 4 years from planting to maintenance.

On September 29, 2022, the Butuan City Water District (*BCWD*) entered into a Memorandum of Agreement (*MOA*) with One Meralco Foundation (OMF) for the implementation of the 80-hectare reforestation project in the Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve (*TRWFR*) and CADT-135 area dubbed as the "Adopt-a-Forest Program: the One for Trees Project in the Taguibo Watershed."

In December 2022, the BCWD attended to the Pre-Field Based Investigation (FBI) Conference for the conduct of Free & Prior Informed Consent (FPIC) to the Indigenous People (IP) within CADT 135 as part of the Information Education & Communication (IEC). BCWD also started to process the procurement of seedlings to commence the project's site preparation and outplanting activities on the same month.


