

Dear Donor:

We have new donors for our Adopt-A-Forest Program for the 2nd semester of 2024. The current Chairman of the BCWD Board of Directors, Atty. Dennis M. Bacala had donated for a 1-hectare Adopt-A-Forest Project. Former member of the BCWD Board of Directors, Leah A. Mendoza also donated 1-hectare for the BCWD's Adopt-A-Forest Project. Signing of Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the new donors will be scheduled within the 2nd semester of 2024.

For the 1st semester of 2024, a total of 152 hectares Adopt-A-Forest Program were maintained in the Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve, the main source of BCWD's main water supply.

The **4**th **pass maintenance of the Adopt-A-Forest Program, planted in April 2023** in partnership with Doc. Lao/Atty. Torralba, ANECO (3rd Donation), and Arch. Horacio Santos was completely validated on May 13, 2024, with a **survival rate of 93.33%**. It covers approximately three (3) hectares of area within Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve (TRWFR), and planted with 1,800 seedlings of various grafted fruits and forest trees such as Rambutan, Lanzones, Narra and Tugas or equivalent to 600 seedlings per hectare.

The 5th pass maintenance of the Adopt-A-Forest Program, planted in February 2023 in partnership with One Meralco Foundation Inc. was completely validated on April 30, 2024, with a **survival rate of 91.62%**. It covers approximately eighty (80) hectares of area within Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve (*TRWFR*), and planted with 48,000 seedlings of various grafted fruits and forest trees such as Rambutan, Lanzones, Narra and Tugas or equivalent to 600 seedlings per hectare.

III. Updates on the Adopt-A-Forest Projects subject for implementation

- 1. BCWD's Adopt-A-Forest Project in partnership with BBY2K20 and ANHS Batch 1999
 - **A.** The Butuan City Water District signed a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the BBY2K20 Organization (BBY2K20) on May 16, 2023, for a 40-hectare reforestation project in the Taguibo River Watershed Forest Reserve (TRWFR).

The BBY2K20 agrees to be a partner in the Adopt-A-Forest Program of the BCWD, which aims to plant approximately 24,000 various species of fruit and forest tree seedlings within the Taguibo Watershed. It has a total budget of Php 3,000,000.00. The BBY2K20 shouldered Php 1,200,000.00 while BCWD will provide a counterpart in the amount of Php 1,800,000.00. Said project has a period of 4 years from planting to maintenance.

B. The Butuan City Water District signed a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the **Agusan National High School (ANHS) Batch 1999**, on July 29, 2023 for the two (2) hectares reforestation project.

The ANHS Batch 1999, represented by its President, Atty. Michelle Palacay Dela Calzada, with address at Gabriel Village, Barangay Libertad, Butuan City.

The ANHS Batch 1999, agrees to be a partner in the Adopt-A-Forest Program of the BCWD. The project aims to reforest a total of two (2) hectares or to plant approximately 1,200 various species of fruit and forest tree seedlings within the Taguibo Watershed. It has a total budget of Php 150,000.00. The ANHS Batch 1999 will shoulder Php 60,000.00 while BCWD will provide a counterpart in the amount of Php 90,000.00. Said project has a period of 4 years from planting to maintenance.

The BCWD has procured the planting materials for the 22 hectares on February 2024 (20 hectares for BBY2K20 – 1st phase and 2 hectares for ANHS Batch 1999). Its site preparation and out-planting activity was originally scheduled on March 2024. In consideration with the El Niño Phenomenon, the BCWD opt to implement the projects on July 2024. The remaining 20 hectares (2nd phase) of BBY2K20 will be implemented on Year 2025.

The Philippine Institute of Civil Engineers (PICE) – Agusan del Norte with office address of Capitol Compound, Brgy. J.P. Rizal, Butuan City, represented by its President, Engr. Cesar T. Palma, Jr., agrees to be a partner in the Adopt-A-Forest Program of the BCWD. The project aims to reforest one (1) hectare or to plant approximately 600 various species of fruit and forest tree seedlings within the Taguibo Watershed.

It has a total budget of Php 75,000.00. The PICE – ADN Chapter will shoulder Php 30,000.00 while BCWD will provide a counterpart in the amount of Php 45,000.00. Said project has a period of 4 years from planting to maintenance.

Site preparation and out-planting activity of the 1-hectare Adopt-A-Forest Project in partnership with PICE – Agusan del Norte Chapter was originally scheduled on April 2024. Due to budget constraints currently facing by the BCWD, this will be implemented on the 2nd semester of 2024.

3. The Butuan City Water District signed a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Agusan del Norte Electric Cooperative (ANECO), on August 25, 2023 for the two (2) hectares reforestation project.

The ANECO, a non-stock, non-profit, electric cooperative with central office address at Km. 2, J.C. Aquino Avenue, Butuan City, represented by its Board of Director President Romeo J. Gumadlas.

The ANECO agrees to be a partner in the Adopt-A-Forest Program of the BCWD. The project aims to reforest a total of two (2) hectares or to plant approximately 1,200 various species of fruit and forest tree seedlings within the Taguibo Watershed.

It has a total budget of Php 150,000.00. The ANECO will shoulder Php 60,000.00 while BCWD will provide a counterpart in the amount of Php 90,000.00. Said project has a period of 4 years from planting to maintenance.

Site preparation and out-planting activity of the 2-hectare Adopt-A-Forest Project in partnership with ANECO was originally scheduled on April 2024. Due to budget constraints currently facing by the BCWD, this will be implemented on the 2nd semester of 2024.
